Welcome and Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 2:30 p.m. by Chair Rick Harrell, who noted that a quorum was present.

Public Comment Period

Chair Harrell solicited public comments. There were none.

Approval of Minutes for September 18, 2024 Meeting

Chair Harrell asked for approval of the minutes from the September 18, 2024, Committee meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Sessoms and seconded by Ms. Lochte and the minutes were unanimously approved as presented.

VEDP FY24 Financial Results (thru 09.30.2024)

Bob Grenell, VEDP Controller, presented the financial results for the three-month period ending September 30, 2024. He shared that all VEDP divisions are close to or below budget, and spending is expected to increase in the remaining quarters of FY25 consistent with prior years

Chair Harrell asked for acceptance of the VEDP FY24 Financial Results through September 30, 2024. A motion was made by Mr. Sessoms and seconded by Ms. Lochte and the financial results were unanimously accepted.

<u>Procurement Protocols Update</u>

Bob Grenell provided an overview of VEDP's procurement policies that were updated in response to legislation passed by the General Assembly in 2023. This legislation requires that

VEDP, along with other state authorities, amend their procurement policies to align with the Virginia Public Procurement Act. The only change required to VEDP's procurement policies was the posting of large procurements, as well as sole source and emergency purchases, on the Department of General Services procurement website and VEDP's website.

Chair Harrell asked for approval of the Procurement Protocols update. A motion was made by Mr. Sessoms and seconded by Mr. Rush and the Procurement Protocols update was unanimously accepted.

Audit Update

Chair Harrell introduced Diana Munoz-Scaggs with FORVIS Mazars, VEDP's audit firm, to provide an update on the status of open audit issues since the September FAC meeting. One remaining audit finding for Human Resources has been validated by FORVIS Mazars and closed. Diana also provided an update on the two audits currently in process for the Business Investment and Incentives divisions. Both audits are expected to be completed in time to report the results at the March FAC meeting.

Mr. Harrell thanked Ms. Munoz-Scaggs for her report.

IT Security Update

Chris Hughes, VP of Information Technology, provided a security update that included the following Items:

- o Review of the five-year IT audit plan
- Audit findings status

Mr. Harrell thanked Mr. Hughes for his report.

Extension Requests

Ms. Goodwin, Senior VP of Business Investment and Incentives, presented an update on incentive-related extension requests, which is summarized below:

Chair Harrell asked for a motion to recommend the extension request. A motion was made by Mr. Sessoms and seconded by Ms. Lochte, and the extension request was unanimously accepted.

Clawback Updates

Ms. Goodwin, Senior VP of Business Investment and Incentives, presented an update on clawback activity, which is summarized below:

Two COF clawbacks requested but not past due yet

- Four COF clawbacks closed out since the September Board meeting
- o Two COF closeouts in process
- One past due clawback (Polycap) referred to the Office of the Attorney General for collection
- One past due VJIP clawback (Ison Furniture). Company received a portion of the grant and is now closed. Recommend project be referred to the Office of the Attorney General for collection
- One data center clawback closeout in process

Chair Harrell asked for a motion to accept the clawback report. Ms. Lochte made a motion to accept the clawback report. Mr. Sessoms seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

FY2025: OPERATIONS BUDGET TO ACTUAL FOR THE SIX MONTHS ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2024

- All divisions are at or below budget through the first six months of the fiscal year.
- The market-facing divisions (Talent Accelerator Program, International Trade, BI Project Management, Strategic Projects and Lead Generation, Innovative Framework Sector Teams, and Marketing and Communications) are under budget (40% combined). This spending rate is expected to increase as we move into the final two quarters of FY25.
- The Projects, Pass Thru's and Grants budget includes \$3.7 million for the Virginia Business Ready Sites Development and Characterization programs, \$2.3 million for the Brownfields Restoration and Redevelopment Fund, and \$2.2 million for the Offshore Wind Supply Chain Development Program. Year-to-date spending through the second quarter includes \$1.1 million for the Brownfields Fund and \$0.4 million for the Virginia Business Ready Sites Program.

Executive Summary

We have completed an assessment of the controls over the Business Investment (BI) Division at the Virginia Economic Development Partnership (VEDP). Our procedures did not identify any internal control design or operating deficiencies.

Audit Report Rating

Satisfactory rating was assigned to this report based on the results of our work. The table below explains the possible ratings and the related rating definitions. ¹

Program Overview

The BI Division is responsible for managing projects between VEDP clients, Virginia's regional and local economic development, and VEDP resources. BI also manages site selection projects and supports business retention and expansion efforts.

Some of the primary job responsibilities of the BI Division include:

- Client management
- Project management
- Documenting and maintenance of opportunities in Salesforce
- Collaborating with Real Estate Solutions to identify and recommend real estate options to clients

- Coordinating with regional and local economic development partners, clients, and VEDP staff during the real estate property research process and site visits
- Submitting all required documentation for Project Review and Credit Committee (PRACC)
 projects receiving VEDP-managed incentives, as well as Major Employment & Investment
 Project Approval Commission (MEI Commission), when applicable
- Submitting project press releases
- Creating initial brief for the Governor Call Program

Objective

To assess the design and operating effectiveness of internal controls over VEDP's BI Division, identify control gaps, and to provide recommendations for improvement.

Scope

Our scope included the current state of controls over the following activities:

- Policies and procedures
- Review and approval of new opportunities entered in Salesforce
- Weekly update of project activity in Salesforce
- Process over requests submitted to Real Estate Solutions
- Site visits
- Project management to include submission of proposal requests to Incentives Division, press releases, confirming incentive amounts, and obtaining approvals from Project Review and Credit Committee (PRACC) and Major Employment & Investment (MEI) as needed
- Client satisfaction surveys

Our sample was based on a population of projects with activity within the period July 1, 2023, through October 31, 2024.

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





REPAYMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR COF UNDERPERFORMANCE

Per the Code of Virginia § 2.2-115. (Commonwealth's Development Opportunity Fund, or COF), all COF performance agreements "shall provide that if the private investment and new job contractual requirements are not met by the expiration of the date stipulated in the contract, including any extension granted by the political subdivision and the Commonwealth, the business beneficiary shall be liable to the political subdivision and the Commonwealth for repayment of a portion of the funds provided by the political subdivision under the contract and liable to the Commonwealth for repayment of a portion of the funds provided from the Commonwealth's Development Opportunity Fund."

JLARC Recommendation No. 24: "The Virginia Economic Development Partnership (VEDP) board of directors should require VEDP to develop and use standard policies and procedures that clearly explain when and how staff should enforce clawback provisions. Enforcement should be consistent and effective for all companies that do not meet their contractual obligations, including wage requirements. The board should require VEDP staff to report regularly to the full board on each project that is subject to a clawback and the repayment status for each project that is subject to a clawback."






